**Procedure: Dust Mop area**  
Remove any stickers, labels or dried soil with scraper  
Place wet floor signs  
Hand mop areas auto scrubber can't reach with neutral cleaner.  
Empty bucket when water becomes soiled.  
Auto wash area with restorer starting at wall and moving toward center of area.  
Scrubber should be operated with squeegee and pads in down position, solution and vacuum on.  
When floor is dry apply spray buff in front of burnisher.  
Burnish area spray buff has been applied.  
Continue until entire area is complete.  
Dust mop if burnisher does not have dust control.  
Remove wet floor signs.
