

Glass Cleaning

Clean Interior Windows

Procedure: Remove blinds or window treatments if necessary.
Always work from the top of the window down.
Depending on size of windows apply solution to one or several windows in a row that will not dry up before you can finish them.
Allow chemical to dwell on surface but do not let dry.
After dwell time agitate with window washer sleeve.
Scrape any items that normal agitation will not remove.
Squeegee solution from glass before it dries, be sure to work to bottom of glass, wiping squeegee after each pass.
Wipe dry all sills and metal and bright work.
Move on to next pre-wet window that chemical has dwelled on and repeat steps.
When a group of windows is complete move to next group and continue above procedure until all windows are done.
Protect floors, carpets, furniture and plants from chemicals.
Consider that glass and plastics should be cleaned with chemicals that are approved for these surfaces.
